# Takes it all Off!



There has been a lot of sadness at Hannanprint NSW recently with the tragic loss of two colleagues to cancer. Their battle with this disease inspired workmates at Hannanprint NSW to join the Leukaemia Foundation's 'World's Greatest Shave to Care and to Cure' event.

The Hannanprint NSW Greatest Shave was co-ordinated by Bob Taylor and Tony Tarrant from the company's Finance department. Staff got right behind the cause as a brave team of nine faced the shaver on the afternoon of Friday 11th March.

A fantastic \$4,000 was raised by employees and this was matched by a further 50% contribution from the company, resulting in a \$6,000 donation to the Leukaemia Foundation.

World's Greatest Shave 2005 was a great success this year with more than 90,000 people across Australia supporting this worthwhile cause by shaving or colouring their hair. The amount raised to date totals

in excess of \$7,606,215 however the Leukaemia Foundation expects to see this total rise even further as money continues to be donated over the next few months in the aftermath of the event.

The Leukaemia Foundation is the only national not-for-profit organization dedicated to the care and cure of patients and families living with leukaemias, lymphomas, myeloma and related blood disorders. Funds raised by the World's Greatest Shave will go towards the accommodation, patient transport, counseling and other practical assistance the Foundation provides to patients and their families. Money raised will also fund ground breaking research into better treatments and cures for the future.
