

Australia's Most Awarded at the 22nd National Print Awards

Despite the fact that strong competition continues to improve the standard of print in Australia, IPMG Printing have once again emerged from the annual National Print Awards as the nation's most awarded print group.

In addition to the record numbers in attendance at the awards night this year, Alf Carrigan, Chairman of the Awards noted that; "Patron participation has increased dramatically, entries and entrant companies have grown each year."

Even with competition this steep IPMG Printing managed to come out on top; winning more medals overall than any other print company in Australia. Hannanprint NSW was awarded seven medals in total this year; Inprint Group and Sinnott Bros were presented with five; whilst Offset Alpine Printing and Craft



Printing won four and two medals respectively.

The record number of entries across thirty categories was evaluated by the judging panel. Each entry was coded to cloak the identity of the entrant and laid out on long tables by the National Print Awards staff for examination.

The brief given to the judges was simple: "The objective of the National Print Awards is – 'To raise the standards and to promote the achievements in excellence of Australian Printing.'"

Chairman of the Judges, Rod Urquhart was very pleased to be able to report that "the standard of work received reflects a skilled and capable industry and to be able to confidently say that Australian printers are the equal of any."
