

Tanks for the suggestion

Offset Alpine Printing have in place a process they call System Improvement, the means by which all employees of the company can make suggestions and submit ideas for improvement in any area of the company. All suggestions are evaluated and processed through Offset Alpine's Quality Assurance system.

Thanks to several System Improvement suggestions, in May the first sod of turf was turned at Offset Alpine Printing for the installation of water tanks.



The tanks are in place to capture rain water off the paper store and can hold up to 45,000 litres of water each. Approximately 6,000 litres a week will also be captured in these tanks from the regular testing of our fire pumping system.

Keith Lee, who developed the project, says, 'The water will initially be used in our reverse Osmosis system supplying water to the presses; however we will be looking at extending its use to other parts of the factory.'

Following rain showers over the past few weeks, the rainwater collection tanks are full and water is now being fed to Offset Alpine's printing process from this supply.
